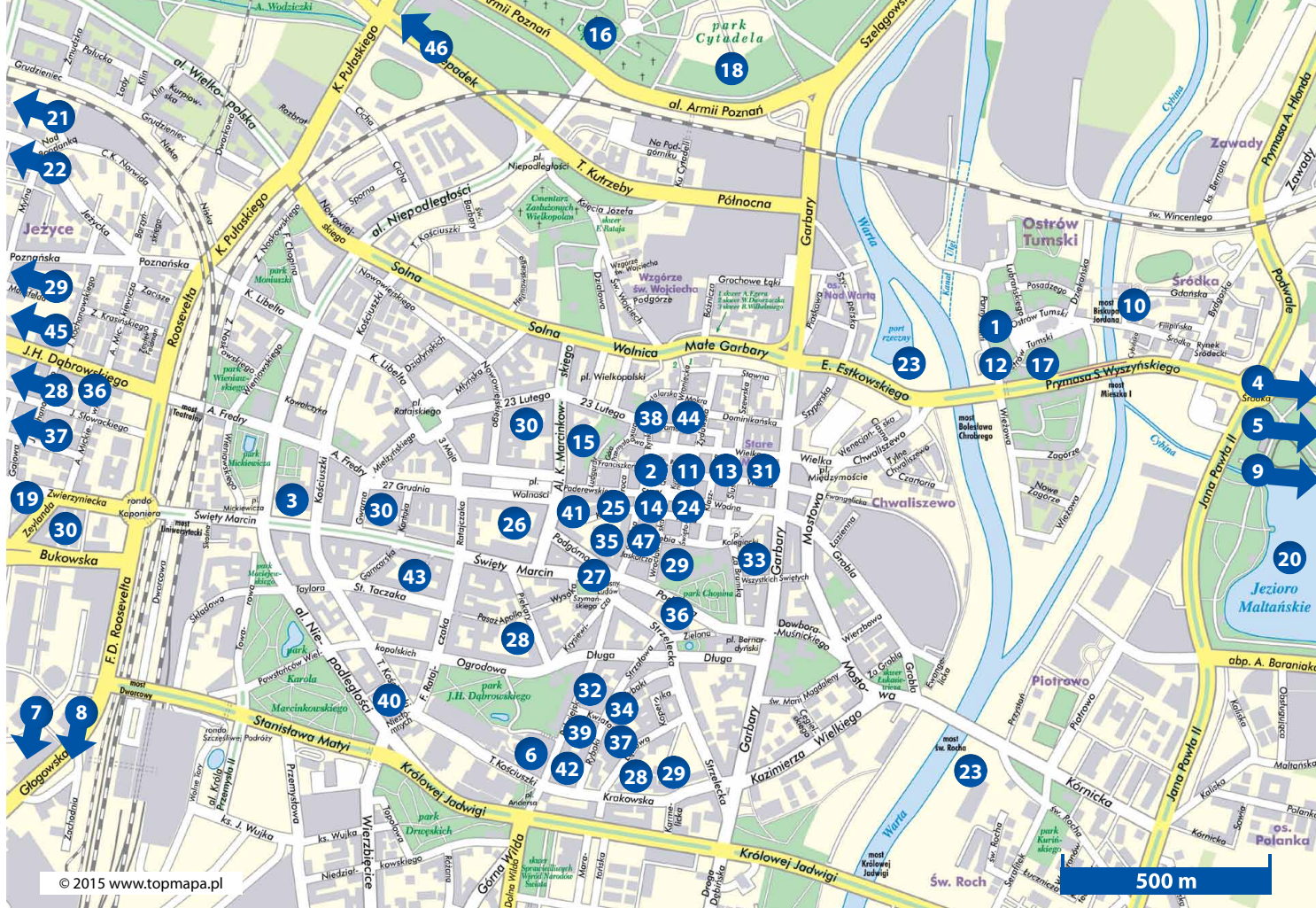

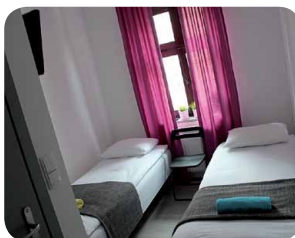

Here is a list of some **FREE** or **AFFORDABLE** **ATTRACTIONS** guaranteed to make your stay in Poznań unforgettable:



1 CATHEDRAL ISLAND

Visit Poland's first **Cathedral church** from the 10th century and see its unique gravestones from the 15th and 16th century. See the **Golden Chapel** with the sarcophagus and statues of Poland's first rulers, as well as the cathedral vaults. Enter the gothic **Blessed Virgin Mary Church**, built in place of a former 10th century princely residence right next to the cathedral. Do not miss the the **Archdiocesan Museum** and the **Genius loci Archaeological Reserve**. Be sure to visit **ICHOT Porta Posnania** – an Interactive Center of the History of the Cathedral Island.

2 TOWN HALL

When at the very heart of Poznań – the Old Market Square, you will certainly cannot miss the Renaissance **Town Hall**, one of the most beautiful monuments of Renaissance architecture in Poland, named by some “the most beautiful north of the Alps”. Its interiors today are home to the **Museum of the History of Poznań**. Be sure to keep in mind Poznań's two most famous **tin billy goats** from the Town Hall tower, who butt their heads 12 times every day at high noon.



3 IMPERIAL CASTLE

The **Imperial Castle** is the last and youngest monarch residence in Europe. It was built for the German emperor, William II. The castle is open to **guided tours** day and night, where you can see its halls, usually inaccessible cellars and attic. This allows you to discover this unique structure, learn its secrets and see all nooks and crannies. www.zamek.poznan.pl

4 FORT III

Fort III is a perfectly preserved artillery fort from 1881, once part of the Poznań Stronghold. Use the opportunity to **visit the fort on your own or with a guide** – **Poznań City Card gives a 50% discount on the ticket**. The tour includes both the underground and the above-ground parts of the structure. The fort is located in the premises of Poznań Zoo, so the additional purchase of a zoo ticket is necessary – **a discounted ticket is available with Poznań City Card**. www.ptpf.org.pl/fort3/zwiedzanie



5 POZNAŃ ZOO

If you are looking for a place to rest and see animals in their near-natural environment, visit Poznań Zoo – **buy a discounted ticket with Poznań City Card**. Follow the **3 mapped trails** to see nearly **2 thousand animals of around 140 species**. Be sure to visit the newly built elephant house and bear enclosure. Tired of walking?

Hop aboard the **Zoo mini-train** and see the zoo from a different perspective. www.zoo.poznan.pl

6 OLD BREWERY

Old Brewery Shopping, Art and Business Center is much more than just a mall – it is also **art**, surrounded by **highest class architecture** reminiscent of the 19th century industrial style. Be sure to pop by! Next to a **multitude of high-end shops**, there are also cafes, clubs, a park, an art center and a luxury hotel. www.starybrowar5050.com

7 POZNAŃ PALM HOUSE

Are you up for a journey through all of the world's climate zones in just one afternoon? Visit Poznań's over a hundred-year-old **Palm House**, the largest in Poland and one of the largest in Europe – **a discounted ticket is available with Poznań City Card**. Around **17 thousand plants of 700 species** and varieties, as well as a large collection of **exotic fish** await you there. www.palmiarnia.poznan.pl

8 ŠKODA AUTO LAB

ŠKODA Auto Lab is an interactive safety center created by the ŠKODA brand, and it combines the automotive education with **family entertainment** – **free admission with Poznań City Card**. Here, you can learn both the rules of safe and eco-friendly driving and the secrets of technology, hidden under the hoods of the cars. All thanks to such attractions as **driving, crash and rollover simulators**, a car cross-section, films, quizzes and other guided **activities for children and youths**. 9 BULA PARK BOULE AND BOWLING

Relax and enjoy active leisure in Bula Park - a unique place in Poznań where bowling enthusiasts can use the only outdoor **bowling alley**, or **play Boule** – **a 50% discount available with Poznań City Card**. 6 fully automated bowling alleys and 5 professional boules-dromes await you. www.malta.poznan.pl

On Saturdays or with Poznań City Card, admission to many MUSEUMS and EXHIBITIONS is FREE or DISCOUNTED. Here are some of them:



10 ICHOT PORTA POSNANIA

ICHOT Porta Posnania is Poland's first heritage interpretation center – **with Poznań City Card, a discount of 33,33% is available**. Thanks to the interactive multimedia exhibition, you can learn about the fates of Poznań's Cathedral Island and the beginnings of Polish statehood. You can follow the mapped **sightseeing trails with an audio-guidebook**. Next to the basic excursion program, a games and activity-based program has been developed specially for children. www.bramapoznania.pl/en

11 ARCHAEOLOGICAL MUSEUM

The only **authentic ancient Egyptian obelisk** in Poland, tools used over a dozen thousand years ago by the first settlers of today's Greater Poland region, face-shaped burial urns - this is just a fraction of Poznań Archaeological Museum's unique collection of historical treasures. A great **part of the exhibitions is interactive**, and visitors can try their hand at creating a rock engraving, become an archaeologist working at an excavation or try on a Medieval knight's chain mail shirt – **on Saturdays and with Poznań City Card**, the admission is free. www.muzarp.poznan.pl/en

12 ARCHDIOCESAN MUSEUM

The museum presents **religious art** which shows the understanding of beauty throughout the centuries, **from the Middle Ages to the modern times** – **with Poznań City Card, admission is free**. The museum's **great asset is a collection of gothic art** – including the largest collection of 14th and 15th century sculptures and paintings in this part of Poland. www.muzeum.poznan.pl



13 MUSEUM OF THE HISTORY OF POZNAŃ

If you want to know more about Poznań's history, be sure to check out this very museum – **on Saturdays and with Poznań City Card, the admission is free**. The exhibition showcases the history of the city from the **13th century to 1945. Among the museum's most precious exhibits are a 13th century gilded and enamelled bishop's staff** from Limoges, a **table clock** with Poznań's coat of arms, made in 1575, as well as 1651 cobblers' guild rummer. The city's 16th century development is shown in the **Royal Hall**. www.mnp.art.pl/en

14 MUSEUM OF MUSICAL INSTRUMENTS

The **only such museum in Poland and third largest in Europe**, with a collection of instruments from all over the globe – **on Saturdays and with Poznań City Card, the admission is free**. The permanent exhibition is a collection of lute instruments. The pearl of the exhibition is the collection of 16th-20th century lute instruments, including the violin of **Marcin Grobicz** (Cracow, ~1600), **Dankwart**, as well as the instruments by the Italian masters. An extensive collection of pianos and a set of wooden and brass instruments are also on permanent exhibition. www.mnp.art.pl/en

15 NATIONAL MUSEUM IN POZNAŃ

In the Ancient Are Gallery you can see a **series of Roman imperial portraits**, unique in Polish collections. In the Polish 16th-18th Century Art Gallery, there is an equally unique collection of **coffin portraits**. On the first floor, there are the collections of Western European art, and the **only collection of Spanish paintings in Poland (with works of Zurbaran, Ribera and Velazquez)**. In Poznań National Museum's collection there is also the **only Claude Monet painting in Poland – Beach in Pourville**. Be sure to pop by the Polish Art Gallery to see the largest assemblage of the works of Jacek Malczewski, as well as paintings by Chelmoński, Podkowiński, Boznańska and the contemporary works of Kantor or Nowosielski. **On Saturdays and with Poznań City Card, the admission is free**. www.mnp.art.pl/en



16 MUSEUM OF ARMAMENTS

The museum is located in the originally preserved former bomb shelter – **on Fridays and with Poznań City Card, the admission is free**. Here you can find an exhibition of military accessories, documents, photographs, plans and relics from the fortress buildings of Poznań Stronghold. Be sure to see the permanent exhibition's **main attraction – the outdoor military equipment park**, with over a dozen military vehicles, planes and helicopters, tanks, many canons, heavy guns and mortars. The oldest exhibits come from the early 19th century. www.muzeumniedlegosci.poznan.pl

17 GENIUS LOCI ARCHAEOLOGICAL RESERVE

If you are interested in **10th century wooden and earthwork fortifications** built by the first settlers from the Piast dynasty, be sure to visit the Genius loci Archaeological Reserve – **on Saturdays and with Poznań City Card, the admission is free**. You can also see the remains of a **fortification investment from the 16th century**. Innovative exhibition solutions, a system of multimedia visualisations and holographic presentations as well as a 3D technology film make this unique place even more interesting. www.muzarp.poznan.pl/en/rezerwat



Poznań also offers excellent opportunities for relaxation among lakes and forests, as well as many attractions for the enthusiasts of active leisure. Here are some of the PARKS and GREEN AREAS worth visiting.



18 CITADEL

The Citadel is **Poznań's largest city park** (~100 hectares), and is one of Poznań residents' favourite places of leisure and relaxation, with a rich museum offer (**Museum of Armaments, “Poznań” Army Museum**). In the park area, there is an instalment of one of **Magdalena Abakanowicz's largest outdoor works, “The Unrecognized Ones”**.

19 OLD ZOO

The Old Zoo is not very big, and so its exhibition has been appropriated to its capabilities. The park area teems with lovely trees, bushes and flowers. In the new **poikilothermic animals pavilion**, in near-natural environment, there are the world's largest lizards – the monitor lizards, as well as many other reptilians such as the poisonous Mexican beaded lizard or the several-meters-long tiger pythons, and amphibians, including gigantic frogs – the Leptodactylus fallax, known as the mountain chickens due to their tasty meat, and many species of fish. www.zoo.poznan.pl

20 MALTAŃSKIE LAKE

Seeking a place to relax and spend your time actively? There is no need to look any further than Maltańskie Lake. Around this artificial lake, located a mere 2 kilometers from the Old Town, there are **walking and cycle paths**, a **beach resort**, **mini golf** and **boule facilities**, an all-year skiing slope and the Adrenaline rollercoaster. Right next door, there is the **aquapark Malta Thermal Bath**, and the route of the **narrow gauge train Maltanka**, which leads to Poznań Zoo, goes along the lake itself. In the winter season, an indoor ice rink is open at the western bank of the lake.



21 STRZESZYNEK LAKE

All year round, the lake and its surrounding forests are an attractive location for active leisure and recreation. Many **running paths** and **cycle routes**, a **beach volleyball pitch**, a **beach resort**, a sports equipment rental, a motel and restaurant, as well as an art gallery are enough to attract many visitors from the city and beyond.



22 RUSAŁKA LAKE

This **nature enclave near the city center** is a popular spot for recreation and relaxation for Poznań residents. The **fishermen fish**, the **cyclists** and **equestrians roam the forest paths**. The lake's serene location is also a favourite among the lovers of jogging and Nordic Walking.

23 WARTA RIVER AREA – POZNAŃ CITY BEACH & MORE

Relaxing in a beach chair, swinging in a hammock, a tasty snack, perhaps even a **beach volleyball match** or a **round of boules** in a specially prepared area? If blissful laziness is your thing, and you also like to do sports, **Poznań City Beach** is THE place for you to be. There are also many outdoor events here, making this location vibrant and lively all summer long. Want to feel the wind in your hair and the river breeze on your face? In the summer, be sure to visit **Old Port by Warta**. There are **three passenger ships** at your disposal. Cruises take place on the routes Old Port – Staroleka – Old Port and Old Port – Karolin – Old Port. A standard cruise is ~70 minutes long. www.facebook.com/PrzystanStaryPortPoznan
