







Museum of Musical Instruments

One of the few in Europe. Its collection of musical instruments consists of about two thousands items from all parts of the world.

Dear visitors, from December 1, 2022 to January 31, 2023 the Museum of Musical Instruments in Poznań will be closed for individual visitors!

Housed in the historic tenant buildings of the Old Market Square, the Museum is the only one of its kind in Poland, ranking the third largest in Europe. Its collection features some 2,000 items from all parts of the world. The permanent exhibition is made up of stringed instruments, a vast collection of pianos, wooden and brass instruments. Individual displays have been devoted to Polish folk instruments and instruments from Africa, Australia and Oceania, Americas, Asia and Europe.
